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Food in Education Briefing

The Food Education Team (FET) will share top line data on the impact of Covid-19 on free school meals including the percentage increase in applications and eligibility. What has been the impact on children's diet during their absence from school? The importance of returning to hot meals, to ensure children have a wide variety of nutrients and don't become fatigued by cold packed lunches.

As part of Lincolnshire's Public Health strategy the FET will briefly touch on compliance of the School Food Standards and how they can support schools/caterers to improve their catering provision. More than ever, it is important that the food provided across the school day is tasty, nutritious and school food compliant. The FET are able to check compliance of school menus as well as drill down into recipes to recommend healthier alternatives with less sugar/fat/salt content. The FET will be joined by a public health colleague from Oral Health to summarise Lincolnshire's Oral Health challenges and how working together we can positively impact on the health outcomes as well as education, attendance and behaviour of Lincolnshire's children.

The FET will share the range of support to enable schools to adopt a whole school approach to a healthy food and drink environment.
